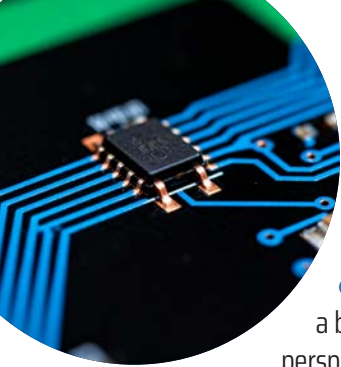

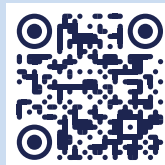


What is a “skill”?

A “skill” is a component of professional expertise developed through the acquisition and application of knowledge, practical abilities, and work-related behaviours associated with a specific occupation. “Skills competitions” are vocational contests based on one or more occupations for which recognised benchmarks, descriptions, or standards exist. They are closely linked to occupational practice because they reflect internationally recognised competencies, are directly relevant to career pathways, and remain applicable over time despite technological and labour-market changes.

The role and purpose of the WorldSkills Competition

The WorldSkills Competition is the premier global event for vocational skills, bringing together young professionals from around the world to demonstrate excellence in their chosen trades and technologies. Participation is typically earned through outstanding performance in national, regional, or continental skills competitions, ensuring competitors represent the highest standards of their professions.



Why FoSterGrowth?

The primary focus of the FoSterGrowth project is to create a system for VET curricula development in several steps, including skills competitions and transnational work-based learning internships. It will focus on electrical and electronics engineering (EEE), a domain with significant growth opportunities and strong demand for employees. The ultimate result of the FoSterGrowth project is to create synergy within the “VET ecosystem” to support the education of youth who choose skilled careers.
